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2024 Sleight of Hand Chardonnay The Enchantress Old Vine French Creek Vineyard

From one of the producer's estate vineyards in the Blue Mountains planted in 1981 with 10 acres of Wente clone, the 2024 Chardonnay The Enchantress Old Vine French Creek Vineyard is indeed from one of the oldest surviving and producing Chardonnay vineyards in the state. Planted to wide, Old School spacing, it's remarkably fresh and complex, after 11 months on the lees with no stirring. Concentrated flavors of crisp apple, golden oak, and light toast ride along a framework of tremendous elegance and light alcohol, a light-bodied but serious wine with the structure to keep going for a decade or more.
