This is a blend of Lewis (61%) and Les Collines vineyard fruit. An appealingly dark color, aromas of red plum, coffee, strawberries and cream, violet, and herb lead to a fruit-filled, mouth-coating, high thread count palate. The vibrant acidity of the vintage supports it. There's depth and intensity aplenty, but it's the overall balance that impresses most. It's the best Levitation the winery has made to date. 14.6% alcohol. TCA-free micro-agglomerated cork. 800 cases produced.
