2022 PSYCHEDELIC "ESTATE" SYRAH STONEY VINE VINEYARD

*Sleight of Hand Cellars
Walla Walla Valley AVA*

Coming from a vineyard in the Rocks District, grapes for this wine were foot stomped, native yeast fermented with stems, and aged 16 months in French oak (10% new). One sniff and it's clear this wine could only come from one place on earth. The aromas erupt from the glass, with notes of charcuterie plate, Kalamata olive brine, fresh chopped parsley, blue fruit, fire pit, and potpourri. The palate is plush-feeling but svelte, flavorful yet deft. Fruit and savory notes linger on the spectacular, 45-second finish. It's outrageously delicious. Best after 2027. 13.3% alcohol. TCA-free micro-agglomerated cork. 500 cases produced.
