2022 SORCERESS "RESERVE" GRENACHE

*Sleight of Hand Cellars
Columbia Valley*

This wine is a blend of WeatherEye (44%), Upland (31%), and French Creek vineyard fruit. It was aged 16 months in neutral French oak puncheons. The aromas are subdued initially, opening to reveal notes of strawberry, rose hips, smoked meat, brown stem, and crushed flower. Luscious, rich, ripe, palate-enveloping, hyper-pure red fruit and blue flavors follow. It shows crystalline clarity. A warm finish caps it off. It's hedonistic Grenache goodness. Some patience is required. Enjoy after 2026. 14.9% alcohol. TCA-free micro-agglomerated cork. 475 cases produced.
