#### 'The Spellbinder' 2022

Sleight of Hand Cellars Red Wine  
Columbia Valley

POINTS

Composed primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon with a blend of other Bordeaux varietals, the 2022 SOH The Spellbinder is aged for 10 months in neutral French oak, allowing its pure fruit character to shine. It presents a radiant medium ruby core with a lively pink-tinged rim. The nose is expressive, revealing layers of macerated blackberries, ripe dark cherries, cedar-laced herbs, and damp earth. On the palate, the wine leans toward an elegant and refined profile, with juicy black fruits complemented by hints of cinnamon bark and subtle spice. Medium-bodied with firm yet approachable tannins, it carries a fresh vibrancy that leads into a smooth, lingering finish.
